For the reasons mentioned in the application, delay of 162 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

Application stands disposed of.

FAO No.4735 of 2015

The deceased who was studying in +2 in non-medical. The Court has assessed compensation at Rs.10.87 Lacs with interest 7.5%. In the manner of assessment, the Court has provided for a notional income of Rs.6,000/-. The argument is that the Court did not provide for prospect for increase over a period of terms and that also the Court must have also awarded and the Court has provided for Rs.15,000/- for funeral expenses.

In **Rajesh and others Vs. Rajbir Singh and others, 2013 (9) SCC 54,** the Court has provided for Rs.25,000/- and if, there is any error somewhere, it is the award of Rs.10,000/- under this head. The reduction by a few thousand

and could not very seriously impact an assessment made at Rs.10.87 Lacs.

I do not think the judgment requires any modification in appeal. The appeal is accordingly, dismissed.
