Counsel for the parties state that in view of a settlement dated
21.7.2015, the appellant has agreed to withdraw the appeal thereby giving
up challenge to the decree of divorce, however, subject to her receiving a
sum of Rs.6 lacs, which is lying with one Mr. Rajesh Grover alias Neeta, the
mediator.
