Counsel for the appellant states that during mediation proceedings before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaithal, parties have resolved their differences by agreeing to part ways. The appeal may, therefore, be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the parties to file an appropriate petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, 'the Act') for dissolution of the marriage.

Counsel for the respondent pleads no instructions.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the appellant, the appeal is dismissed as withdrawn, with liberty to the parties to file an appropriate petition under Section 13-B of the Act. Liberty is also granted to the parties to seek revival of this appeal in case petition under Section 13-B of the Act, is not filed.
