2. This is an appeal against the judgment and order of the learned Single Judge dismissing the appellant's petition seeking regularization of his services. After this judgment, the same learned Judge dealt with and disposed of a group of writ petitions, one of which was CWP No.10017 of 2011. The learned Judge allowed those petitions. The learned Judge had taken a different view in the subsequent matter *inter alia* in view of the judgment of Supreme Court in **Hari Nandan Prasad and another Versus Employer I/R to Mangmt. of FCI and another**. We have by separate orders and judgments passed today, dismissed the appeals against those judgments being LPA Nos.1903 and 1909 of 2014. It is contended by the appellant that he is similarly situated as the petitioners in those petitions.

3. In these circumstances, the order and judgment in this appeal is

set aside. The respondents are directed to consider the appellant's case for regularization. Appeal is accordingly allowed. This order shall be complied with within a period of eight weeks from today.
