The appeal is for enhancement of compensation for the injuries suffered in a motor accident. This is a case of fracture involving hospitalization for about 43 days. The doctor assessed the disability @ 9%. The Court to provide for loss of amenity for disability @ 18,000/-, Rs. 1,50,000/- for medical expenses, Rs. 80,000/- for pain and suffering and Rs. 50,000/- as attendant charges, transportation charges, diet and nutrition charges. The counsel appearing for the petitioner would argue that the Tribunal has not provided for future loss of income and prospect of future medical expenses. There is no basis for the claimant under both the heads. The court has assessed adequate compensation under all the relevant heads and I do not find if there is any scope for modification.

The appeal is dismissed with above observations.
