The present Letters Patent Appeal is directed against the order passed by the learned Single Judge of this Court on 14.11.2013, whereby the claim of the appellant challenging his wrong fixation of pay, remained unsuccessful.

This Court on 26.5.2015 directed the respondents to reconsider the case of the appellant regarding pay fixation at the time of initial recruitment with further stipulation that the appellant shall not be entitled to any arrears on account of pay fixation but shall be entitled to revised pension prospectively. In terms of such direction, an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police (Headquarters), Bathinda has been filed pointing out the pay fixation has been made vide the order dated 11.8.2015 (Annexure R/1).

In view of the said fact, no further orders are called for in the present appeal.

Dismissed.
