Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Sirsa to Hisar.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under various provisions of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005 at Hisar. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel 90 kilometers from Hisar to Sirsa on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Sirsa is transferred to Hisar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
