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KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Appellant-claimant has impugned the award dated 8.12.2014, passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Ambala, (in short 'Tribunal') wherein the Tribunal recorded injuries suffered by the appellant-claimant in the motor vehicle accident and Rs. 83,000/- as compensation alongwith 7.5% per annum interest was allowed.

It comes out that the claimant had produced medical bills amounting to Rs. 53,459/-. However, the Tribunal awarded Rs. 55,000/- for the medical bills. There was 5% disability and there was 9 days' admission in the hospital, for which Rs. 20,000/- have been awarded. For nutritious diet Rs. 4,000/- and for attendant, Rs. 4,000/- have been awarded. From its face, sufficient compensation has been awarded and there is no scope for enhancement of compensation awarded by the Tribunal.

Accordingly, the present appeal is dismissed.
