[1]. Learned counsel for the respondents stated at the bar that this appeal has arisen out of a suit for permanent injunction which was dismissed by the trial Court and appeal to that effect was also dismissed by the Lower Appellate Court. Thereafter, respondents filed suit for possession and in due course, their suit has been decreed and appeal against the said judgment and decree is pending before the lower Appellate Court at the instance of present appellant.
