RAJIVE BHALLA, J. (ORAL)

The appellant challenges judgment dated 20.09.2014, passed by the District Judge, Family Court, Faridabad, rejecting his application for custody of the minor.

Counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant gives up the custody and guardianship of the minor but may be granted visitation rights.

Counsel for the respondent states on instructions from the respondent, who is present in Court, that she has no objection if visitation rights are granted to the appellant.

We have heard counsel for the parties and with consent of the parties, who are present in Court, affirm the impugned order insofar as it has denied guardianship and custody of the minor to the

appellant but modify the judgment in the following terms: -

- (1) The respondent shall ensure that the minor-Abhirath Trehan is produced before the Secretary, Legal Services Authority, Faridabad, at 02:30 PM on the first Friday of every month to meet and interact with the appellant from 02:30 PM to 04:30 PM.**
- (2) The meeting shall take place under the supervision of the Secretary, Legal Services Authority, Faridabad or such officer as the Secretary may nominate in this regard.**
- (3) The appellant shall pay Rs.5,000/- to the minor at every meeting.**
- (4) In case, the appellant is unable to come for a meeting, he shall inform the father of the respondent, well in advance.**

Parties would be at liberty to file an appropriate application if they require modification of visitation rights.

With the above modification, the present appeal is disposed of.
