The appellant has come up in appeal against the judgment of the lower appellate Court dated 09.11.2009 whereby the suit of the plaintiff has been decreed. The plaintiff was not communicated the adverse entries and on account of those entries, he was not granted the benefit of ACP promotional scale after completion of 16 and 24 years of service, 16 years service with effect from 17.03.2001 and 24 years service with effect from 01.08.2003. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of **Dev Dutt Vs. Union of India 2008 (3) SCT 429** has held that all the entries whether good or adverse should be communicated to the public servant. In the absence of communication of adverse entries, the employee could not be denied the benefit admissible to him as he had no opportunity to file any representation against adverse entries. There is no contrary view of the Hon'ble Supreme Court after the judgment of Dev Dutt (supra).

Since no substantial question of law arises in this appeal,
this appeal is dismissed.
