The present Letters Patent Appeal under Clause X of the Letters Patent is directed against an order passed by the learned Single Bench of this Court on 20.04.2015 whereby the orders passed by the authorities under the Punjab Land Revenue Act, 1887 appointing Suraj Bhan as Lambardar remained unsuccessful.

The Collector, Sonapat, vide order dated 22.12.2011 appointed Suraj Bhan as Lambardar. It was noticed that the petitioner lives out of the village to earn his livelihood, therefore, he will not be able to spare that much time which a person living in the village could spare for getting the work of the villagers done.

Such order was upheld by the Commissioner, Financial Commissioner and also by the learned Single Bench. We do not find that any interference is called for in the present appeal in view of the concurrent findings of fact recorded by the authorities under the Act.

In view thereof, the present Letters Patent Appeal is dismissed.
