SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

These three LPA Nos. 1100, 1101 and 1118 of 2015 are directed against the common order dated 06.07.2015 passed by learned Single Judge, dismissing the writ petitions of Guest Faculty Teachers who are alleged to have become surplus.

Learned Senior Counsel for the appellants, at the outset, point out that learned Single Judge has relied upon a letter dated 30.05.2015 of the District Elementary Education Officer, Fatehabad to hold that the appellants are surplus. They submit that the above stated document was taken on record on the last date of hearing, hence the appellants could not rebut the same. It is their case that the said document could not be relied upon it being contrary to the Rules as well as the details of vacancies furnished by the State Government [Annexure 'B'].

Since the documents [Annexures 'A' and 'B'] were not placed for consideration of learned Single Judge, learned Senior Counsel submit and rightly so that they may be permitted to approach learned Single Judge by way of appropriate application[s] for review/modification of the judgment under appeal, dated 06.07.2015.

Ordered accordingly.

Needless to say that the appellants through their applications may show that the TGTs in the subjects of Social Study, Hindi and Mathematics are not surplus.

The filing of the instant appeal shall not be an impediment before the learned Single Judge to entertain the applications proposed to be filed by the appellants.
