- 3.) Having heard learned counsel for the appellant and taking into consideration all the facts and circumstances, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this appeal with a direction that the election of Board of Directors, if held, shall be subject to final outcome of the writ petition filed by the appellant and the election if so held shall not

render the writ petition as infructuous. In other words, the event of election shall cause no prejudice to the rights of the appellant.
