Against the interim order dated October 31, 2014, passed
in this Letters Patent Appeal respondents No. 1 and 3 filed SLP (c)
No.(s).33121 of 2014, before the Apex Court, which was disposed of
by passing the following order:

"We have heard the learned counsels for the parties.
At the outset, we take on record the statement made
by Shri Dushyant A. Dave, learned Senior Counsel
appearing for the first respondent that the first
respondent who is the appellant in the LPA before
the High Court had only sought for expunction of
certain remarks recorded in the order of the learned

Single Judge is willing to tender unqualified apology and on that basis the said remarks may be expunged and LPA may be closed.

Having taken on record the aforesaid statement, we permit the first respondent to move the Division Bench of the High Court for closure of the LPA filed by him in the above terms. The Division Bench of the High Court after hearing the parties would naturally pass appropriate orders.

Insofar as the matter before the learned Single Judge is concerned, we are of the view that instead of transferring the same as proposed in our earlier order the said matter be heard by the High Court and the matter may be assigned to a Bench by the Hon'ble Acting Chief Justice of the Punjab and Haryana High Court as may be considered appropriate.

With the aforesaid observations, the present special leave petition is disposed of."

The appellant Mr. Saurav Khurana, who is present in the Court tenders unconditional apology and prays that the adverse remarks made against him in the impugned order be expunged. The unconditional apology tendered by the appellant is accepted and the

adverse remarks made against him in the impugned order is hereby expunged.

With the aforesaid, this LPA is disposed of.
