Challenge in the present letters patent appeal under Clause X of the Letters Patent is to an order passed by the learned Single Bench of this Court on 21.5.2015, whereby the appellants were directed to pay ex-gratia financial assistance of Rs.5.00 lacs.

The argument of learned Counsel for the appellants is that the ex-gratia financial assistance has been awarded as contemplated in the policy notified in the year 2005 pursuant to an amendment in the Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the Dependents of the Deceased Employee Rules, 2003, whereas the respondents are governed by the aforesaid Rules of 2003 itself which were notified on 28.2.2003.

We do not find any merit in the argument raised.

It is only the question of quantification of ex-gratia financial

assistance, the State has come in appeal. We do not find any error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge, which may warrant any interference in the present intra court appeal when the ex-gratia financial assistance has been ordered to be paid as per the prevalent policy.

Dismissed.
