This intra-court appeal under Clause X of the Letters Patent has been filed against the order dated 03.07.2015 passed by the learned Single Judge, whereby the writ petition (CWP No. 12989 of 2015) filed by the appellant challenging the selection process made in the year 2006-07 has been dismissed.

Though there is delay of 17 days in filing the appeal and the appellant has filed application (CM No. 3079-LPA of 2015) for condoning the said delay, yet we have heard learned counsel for the appellant on merits and have gone through the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition of the

appellant after observing that the appellant challenged the selection process which was initiated in the year 2006 and finalized in the year 2007, after about seven years, without explaining any reason for long delay in filing the petition. Not only this, it has also been noticed that the appellant had participated in the selection process and interview for the post of Head Master/Head Mistress (HES-II) under BC category and he was not selected as he secured less marks.

It has been observed that when the appellant himself participated in the selection process, there was no reason for him to challenge the same after a long delay. It has also been held that merely because the appellant secured less marks in the interview, he cannot challenge the selection process.

Before us, learned counsel for the appellant could neither controvert the aforesaid factual position nor could point out any illegality in the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge.

No merit. Dismissed.
