1. Whether Reporters of local papers may be allowed to see the judgment?

Rajive Bhalla, J.

The appellant challenges order dated 17.9.2015 dismissing her petition. The appellant's grievance relates to transmission poles and high tension wires that traverse her land.

Counsel for the appellant submits that even as per the report (Annexure A-2) prepared by the committee, one tower/pole would suffice for traversing the appellant's land with high tension wires but the respondents have affixed a large number of transmission towers that have in essence ruined appellant's land.

We have heard counsel for the appellant and perused the impugned order.

Admittedly, the appellant approached this Court after the respondents had erected the towers and drawn the transmission lines. The

mode and manner of installing the towers and transmission lines is a technical matter that is best left to the respondents and, therefore, does not call for interference.

The appeal is, however, disposed of by directing the respondents to consider whether it is possible to use one tower for the remaining work.
