SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

- 1.) On the previous date of hearing when the case was argued at length, we persuaded learned Additional Advocate General, Punjab to impress upon the authorities to reconsider the whole matter. Consequently, the authorities have re-visited the issue and have taken a decision to re-call the order whereby services of the first respondent were de-regularized. This decision has been taken as a one-time measure so as not to become a precedent.
- 2.) We appreciate the gesture shown by the Authorities.

Consequently, the present appeal is disposed of with a direction that the order of de-regularizing the services of first respondent stands revoked and he shall be deemed to be continuing in service as a regular employee for all intents and purposes. As the matter has since been settled by the Authorities, there shall be no cost, compensation or otherwise, on the appellants by the learned Single Judge and the writ petition shall be taken to have been disposed of as infructuous.
