The present application has been filed for condonation of delay of 47 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

For the reasons mentioned in the application, which is duly supported by an affidavit, delay of 47 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

LPA No.2028 of 2014 (O&M)

The appellant was provisionally admitted to the Engineering College i.e. the respondent Institute subject to his passing diploma in Food Technology. Out of 9 subjects of the diploma course, the appellant passed in 8 subjects but got re-appearance in one. Since he could not complete the diploma course, his conditional admission in Engineering College was cancelled.

The aggrieved appellant came to this Court, but the learned Single Judge vide order under appeal dated 11.09.2014 has declined to interfere in the matter.

It may be mentioned here that the appellant was asked to re-appear in one of the subjects of diploma course due to shortage of attendance.

We consequently issued notice of motion to call upon the respondents-Institute to explore the possibility of relaxation in the shortage of attendance, if any.

Learned counsel for the parties inform that the appellant has meanwhile been granted admission in the left out subject of the diploma course and he is regularly attending the classes. He would appear in the left out paper of the diploma course examination in April 2015. Once he successfully qualifies the same and becomes eligible for admission to the degree course, we have no reason to doubt that the respondent College shall consider his claim as per his merit in the entrance test.

If the entrance test is held before the declaration of the

appellant's result for the left out paper of diploma course, he shall be permitted to appear in the same provisionally so that in case he qualifies the left out paper then he may pursue the degree course.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Ordered accordingly.
