This intra-court appeal under Clause-X of the Letters Patent has been filed against the order dated 21.11.2014 passed in CWP No.23908 of 2014, by learned Single Judge, whereby the writ petition filed by the appellant seeking direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to evict respondent No. 4 and 5, her son and daughter-in-law, from the house in question, was dismissed being not maintainable.
