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SATISH KUMAR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

Appellant took admission in B.Com. in the Sports Quota category. He neither attended the classes nor attended any sport activity. Up to 05.12.2015, as against 75%, required as per the University norms, attendance of the appellant is 25.21%. The earlier writ petition (CWP No. 10102 of 2015) filed by the appellant was disposed of on 19.05.2015, after the apology tendered by the appellant that he will not cause any misconduct or misbehaviour in the college or anywhere else and shall regularly attend the classes. In spite of that, he has not done so. When he was not permitted to appear in the examination due to shortage of attendance, he filed writ petition (CWP No. 25241 of 2015) which has been dismissed by the learned Single Judge vide order dated 09.12.2015, after noticing all these facts. He

challenged that order by filing present Letters Patent Appeal.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellant and looking into the past record of the appellant as well as the alleged shortage of his attendance without any justification, we are not inclined to entertain this appeal.

Dismissed.
