This is an appeal against the order of the learned Single Judge issuing notice of motion but declining any interim relief. The impugned order does not contain any reason. We, therefore, heard the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant on the issue of interim relief.

2. We do not see any reason to interfere with the order of suspension passed by the respondent-Deputy Commissioner and confirmed by the Addl. Chief Secretary. The term of the appellant in any event is to come to an end on 31.03.2015. There is a serious issue as to whether the property which the appellant has purchased belongs to another Gram Panchayat and if so whether there was any illegality in respect thereof.

3. In these circumstances we do not consider it necessary to issue any interim orders at this stage. If the order is likely to have any other consequence including debarring the appellant from holding any public office in future, it is always open to the appellant to press for interim relief on the returnable date of notice of motion i.e. 23.02.2015.

Dismissed.
