SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

1.) This Letters Patent Appeal assails two interlocutory orders dated 03.02.2014 and 05.01.2015 passed by learned Single Judge. Vide the first order, the appellant's writ petition pertaining to seniority dispute was admitted with a rider that the same shall be listed as per turn and "no application for early hearing shall be entertained". Vide subsequent order dated 05.01.2015, learned Single Judge declined to recall his previous order dated 03.02.2014.

2.) We have heard learned counsel for the parties. Since a notice in one of the miscellaneous application already stands issued,

it is not necessary for us to embark upon the maintainability of this appeal. Suffice it to say and direct in the interest of justice that if the appellant would be able to make out a case for out of turn hearing of his writ petition, the observations and remarks made by learned Single Judge in the order dated February 3, 2015 would not cause any impediment for such out of turn hearing.
