SURYA KANT, J. [ORAL]

The appellant impugns the order dated 22nd April, 2015 passed by learned Single Judge whereby his writ petition seeking to quash Medical Unfit Certificates dated 19th January, 2015 and 20th February, 2015 declaring him medically unfit to be appointed as GP-X in Air Force, has been dismissed.

In view of the fact that the appellant has been declared medically fit by the Medical Boards constituted by the Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh and All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi vide certificates dated 25.03.2015 [P-5] and 05th May, 2015 [Photostat copy placed on record], we are of the considered view that the respondent – Authorities are required to either constitute a Review Medical Board to re-consider the medical fitness of the appellant or they may verify the original medical certificates relied upon by the appellant. Let an appropriate decision in this regard be taken within one week and if the appellant is found medically fit, desirability of offering him appointment shall also be considered within one month thereafter.

Disposed of. Dasti.
