SURYA KANT, J. (ORAL)

1.) The appellants are Guest Faculty Teachers serving in the State of Haryana. They are aggrieved by direction number (b) contained in the order dated 01.05.2015, passed by learned Single Judge, directing that in case the services of surplus staff are not dispensed with by the next date, the Chief Secretary shall be present in Court to explain why the State Exchequer has been burdened with such a huge liability.

2.) The order reveals that matter is now listed before learned Single Judge for further consideration on 11.05.2015.

3.) In our considered view, the plea taken by the appellants that the Guest Faculty Teachers may be allowed to continue till they are replaced by regularly selected candidates can be effectively raised by them before the learned Single Judge on the date fixed. We request the learned Single Judge to consider this aspect of the matter, after giving an opportunity of hearing to the appellants. If any adverse order is passed against the appellants meanwhile, they may bring this fact to the notice of the learned Single Judge.
