The instant Letters Patent Appeal is directed against an inter-locutory order dated 17.03.2015 whereby learned Single Judge has vacated the ad-interim stay order and admitted the writ petition for final hearing.

We find from the record that the writ petition was ordered to be listed for hearing within six months which are likely to end in the next month.

Instead of pressing this appeal, counsel for the appellant submits that in the interest of justice, writ petition may be directed to be listed for final hearing.
