By filing the present intra-court appeal, the appellant seeks to challenge the judgment of learned Single Judge of this court, vide which the writ petition filed by the appellant seeking a direction for consideration of the claim of his son for admission in five-years course of Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry in the category of Tsunami Victims (Ward/Children) of the ex-servicemen, was dismissed.

The appellant filed the writ petition seeking a direction to respondent No. 2-University to provide reservation for Tsunami victims at Campbell Bay Island in Andaman & Nicobar Island, which was discontinued during the current session. The learned Single Judge dismissed the writ petition finding that the policy having been discontinued after 10 years, this court cannot direct enforcement of the policy. Learned counsel for the appellant has not even produced the policy, enforcement/implementation of which is being sought. The area of Campbell Bay Island in Andaman & Nicobar Island was effected by Tsunami way back in the year 2004. In the absence of any material on record in the form of complete

policy, we do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge.

For the reasons mentioned above, the appeal is dismissed.
