Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition filed by the wife under Order XXXIII Rules 1 and 2 CPC in the court at Barnala to Samrala on the ground of jurisdiction for which a separate remedy is available under Order VII Rule 11 CPC and any other ground other than that has not been pleaded herein.

Counsel for the petitioner, however, states that the application (Annexure A-7) under Order VII Rule 11 CPC was moved before the court below on 13.3.2009 but the same has not been decided as yet.

It is very strange that an application of 2009 is pending before the court below.

Report be called of the concerned presiding officer of the court below and in the meanwhile, the court below is directed to decide the said application, if not decided earlier, within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
