**Rajesh Bindal, J.**

The plaintiff having failed in both the Courts below has filed the present appeal. She filed a suit for mandatory injunction for directing the respondents-defendants to settle the accounts with her and also restraining them from using police pressure for settlement of accounts with her.

The case set up by the appellant was that she was an employee of the company. The respondent company had embezzled the amount deposited by the people. It was further alleged that the respondent company was not returning the money to the depositors.

The case set up by the company was that the husband of the appellant had taken huge loan from the defendants but the same was not being returned. For the embezzlement committed by the appellant, the company had filed a criminal complaint against her which was pending. Both the courts below found that case for rendition of accounts could not be filed by an employee as the same was maintainable only on behalf of a partner. The suit was filed by the appellant after the company had already filed a complaint against her for embezzlement of amount. Injunction could not be granted from prosecuting the appellant.

Nothing could be pointed out by learned counsel for the appellant which could enable this Court to opine that the findings recorded are perverse.

No substantial question of law arises. The appeal is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the accompanying application is dismissed.
