The plaintiffs are before this court aggrieved against the judgments and decrees of both the courts below, whereby they were declined relief to the extent of sale of property to them as per policy of the Government. The appeal is accompanied by an application seeking condonation of delay of 400 days in filing thereof.

Both the courts below, while granting relief to the appellants to the extent that they being in possession will not be dispossessed unless in due course of law, declined relief for sale of property to them at reserve price, as no policy was produced on record which could entitle the appellants to allotment of land at reserve price. There is no merit in the present appeal. No substantial question of law arises.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the accompanying applications are also dismissed.
