Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 filed by the grandparents of minor Nasib, daughter of Sarwan, from the Court of District Judge, Family Court, Hisar to a court of competent jurisdiction at Kaithal.

It is also urged that the petitioner apprehends grave threat to her life and limb at the hands of the respondents and their henchmen, as is evident from the perusal of Annexures P-2 and P-3, appended with the petition. It is further urged that distance between Kaithal and Hisar is approximately 150 kilometers and the petitioner will have to face grave hardship while travelling along with her two minor children.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 25 of the Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 pending before District Judge (Family Court), Hisar is transferred to District Judge, Kaithal. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
