Petitioner is the proprietor of the Rice Mill and for non
supplying of required/stipulated quantity and quality of custom milled rice
for the year 2010-11, the State Procuring Agencies lodged an FIR No.15

dated 05.03.2012 for offences punishable under Sections 420 and 406 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sehna, District Barnala.

It is pointed out that this Court vide order dated 28.05.2012 has dismissed the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail, however, the matter was kept pending for FCI to apprise the Court regarding framing/modification of the policy relating to the various aspect of procurement and storage of foodgrains.

Learned Senior Advocate appearing for the FCI states that the status report at periodical intervals have been filed which reveals that the required Policies are in place and no further adjudication is required.

Keeping in view the statement made by the learned Counsel for the FCI, no further orders are required to be passed.

Disposed of as infructuous.
