Prayer in this appeal is for setting aside the judgments and decree passed by the Courts below, whereby the suit filed by the respondent-plaintiff for ejectment of the appellant-defendant from the shop, has been decreed.

2. There are concurrent findings recorded by the Courts below on the basis of which the ejectment of the appellant-defendant has been ordered and the suit decreed.

3. Counsel for the appellant-defendant informs the Court that the possession of the shop has also been handed over to the respondent-plaintiff about two months back.

4. I have with the assistance of the counsel gone through the judgments passed by the Courts below but do not find any illegality in the same, which would call for interference by this Court. Further, there is no substantial question of law which arises for consideration of this Court.

5. The appeal, therefore, stands dismissed.

6. In view of the dismissal of the appeal itself, all the pending

applications stand disposed of.
