This application under Order 23 Rule 1 read with Section 151 CPC for disposing of the instant appeal, as per the terms of the compromise (Annexure A-1) has been filed by the counsel for the applicant/appellants. It is mentioned in the application that during the pendency of the appeal, parties have compromised the matter and as such, the appellants do not want to continue with the instant appeal and the same can be disposed of in view of the compromise (Annexure A-1) dated 10.01.2015. True copy of the compromise is annexed with this application as Annexure A-1. Learned

counsel for the respondent has also submitted that the parties have compromised the matter vide this compromise (Annexure A-1). So in these circumstances, this application stands accepted and the appellant is permitted to place on record true typed copy of the compromise (Annexure A-1).

2. This CM stands disposed of accordingly.

1. It is submitted by both the learned counsel for the parties that the matter has been settled between both the parties vide compromise (Annexure A-1). So this appeal stands accepted and disposed of in terms of the compromise (Annexure A-1). As a result thereof, impugned judgment and decree dated 26.09.2013 passed by the learned Additional District Judge, Kurukshetra is set aside and the suit for possession by a decree of specific performance of agreement to sell dated 31.10.2001 in respect of suit land measuring 8 kanals filed by the respondent-plaintiff before the learned trial Court stands dismissed.

2. Both the parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the compromise (Annexure A-1).

3. Decree sheet, if any, in terms of compromise (Annexure A-1), be prepared.
