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**KULDIP SINGH, J. (ORAL)**

Report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to the effect that the parties have arrived compromised. The report is accompanied by the statement made by the parties, in terms of the settlement. An amount of Rs.10,00,000/- has been paid to the appellant by way of Demand Draft No. 000365 dated 09.12.2015. Learned counsel for the appellant admits that Rs.7,00,000/- were earlier received through cheque bearing No.668932 dated 30.07.2015 drawn on State Bank of Patiala, Bakshiwal, Punjab. It is also admitted that now entire claim of the plaintiff has been satisfied.

In view of the matter, the present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn as the claim of the plaintiff has been satisfied. The suit filed before the Lower Court also stands dismissed as withdrawn as fully satisfied. The money deposited by the plaintiff before the Lower Court for the execution of the sale deed shall be refunded to him.

As the matter has been compromised by way of through the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, the Court fee paid by the plaintiff shall also be refunded to him.

In view of above, present appeal is dismissed as withdrawn.
