Prayer in this application is for condonation of delay of 111 days in refiling the appeal.

The reason for the delay in refiling the appeal has been mentioned in Para 2 of the application, according to which, on the Registry having raised objections, the paper book of the appeal was returned to the counsel, who, by mistake, had misplaced the same and it was traced with great efforts and ultimately the appeal was refiled after removing the objections, which resulted in delay of 111 days in refiling the appeal.
