Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Panipat to Jind as the petitioner is residing at Jind, which is approximately 70 Kms. away from Panipat.

2. It is also urged that the parents of the petitioner-wife have already expired and there is no male member in her family to accompany her. Besides this, she has apprehension that the respondent-husband can cause physical harm to her when she would visit Panipat to attend the court proceedings because criminal cases remained pending between the parties as is apparent from the perusal of documents Annexure R-2 and R-4 annexed by the respondent.

3. Keeping in view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the facts and circumstances explained in the petition, the

request of the petitioner is allowed.

4.           Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Act pending before District Judge, Panipat is transferred to District Judge, Jind. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

5.           Disposed of accordingly.
