Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 25 of the Hindu Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for for custody of the minor child born out of the wedlock from Bathinda to Mansa.

It is urged that the parties are involved in three different type of litigations, out of which two petitions are under Section 9 and 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 and one under Section 25 of the Hindu Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 filed at the instance of the respondent-husband. It is claimed that in these circumstances, it will be very difficult for her to travel frequently from Mansa to Bathinda on each and every date of hearing in all these cases.

This aspect is not disputed by the respondent. In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 25 of the Hindu Guardian and Wards Act, 1890 pending at Bathinda is transferred to District Judge, Mansa who may entrust it to any other competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
