Counsel for the petitioners seeks transfer of execution application pending in the Court of Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Hoshiarpur to Amritsar by urging that petitioner No.1 is a lady and it is very inconvenient for her to travel all the way to Hoshiarpur from Amritsar on every date of hearing. It is further urged that earlier the respondent was working at Hoshiarpur but he has now been transferred to District Amritsar and his department is already sending draft of his 1/3rd salary to the petitioners at their home.

Perusal of the paper book reveals that there was no representation on behalf of the respondent despite service on 7.2.2014 and thereafter on 6.10.2014. Even today, none has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, thus, proceeded against ex-parte.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioners as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the execution application pending in the Court of Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Hoshiarpur is transferred to District Judge, Amritsar who may further transfer the same to the competent court of jurisdiction at Amritsar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
