Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Gurdaspur to Tarn Taran.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Tarn Taran. Besides this, distance between Tarn Taran and Gurdaspur is approximately 115 kilometers and it would be very difficult for the petitioner to perform journey to this extent, on each and every date of hearing.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Gurdaspur is transferred to Tarn Taran. Both the

concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
