After making appearance on 22.10.2013 through Sh. H.S. Grewal, Advocate, the respondent is not being represented by anyone.

Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, urges that the petition under Section 25 read with Section 7 of the Guardians and Wards Act, 1890 as also under Section 6 of the Hindu Minority and Guardianship Act, 1956 filed by the husband, respondent herein, is pending adjudication at Rohtak whereas the petitioner-wife is residing at Hissar and it is difficult for her to prosecute her defence effectively and competently by travelling from Hissar to Rohtak as she has to look after a minor school going child aged about nine years.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the above mentioned petition pending adjudication before District Judge, Rohtak is transferred to the court of competent jurisdiction at Hissar. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
