Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by a decree of divorce from Ferozepur to Faridkot.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. at Faridkot. Besides this, distance between Faridkot and Ferozepur is approximately 50 kilometers. It is further alleged that the husband and his two young sons from his pre-deceased wife give her merciless beating and she apprehends threat perception at their hands at Ferozepur.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage

Act, 1955 pending at Ferozepur is transferred to Faridkot. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
