Opportunity to file reply is declined.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for restitution of conjugal rights from Pathankot to Gurdaspur.

It is also urged that the respondent-husband is also facing proceedings in an FIR inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC at Gurdaspur. Besides this, it is very difficult for her to travel from Gurdaspur to Pathankot on each and every date of hearing along with her two minor children.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Pathankot is transferred to District Judge, Gurdaspur who may entrust it to any other competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 22.4.2015.

The petition stands disposed of.
