Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner states that in addition to the distance required to be travelled from Bhiwani to Narnaul by the petitioner-wife, there is another FIR case pending against the respondent-husband at Bhiwani. No particulars thereof have been given. Counsel for the respondent states that FIR No.299/2013 inter-alia under Section 498-A IPC has since been cancelled. This fact has not been disputed. However, Counsel for the petitioner states that the protest petition has been filed.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained by them, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Narnaul is transferred to District Judge, Bhiwani who may assign it to any competent court. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Parties to appear before the transferee court on 7.7.2015.

The petition stands allowed.
