By way of this petition under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 (for short 'CPC') petitioner-wife Pooja @ Sandhya seeks transfer of a petition filed by her husband under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 from the Court of learned Civil Judge (Senior Division), Bathinda to a Court of competent jurisdiction at Chandigarh.

It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner that she is residing with her parents at Chandigarh and has a minor child to take care of. In these circumstances, it is not possible for her to attend the proceedings before the Court at Bathinda. It is also pointed out that two petitions, one under Section 125, Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and another under Sections 232, 406, 498-A, 452, 506, 120-B, IPC, have already been transferred on similar grounds and are pending before Courts at Chandigarh.

Though the prayer is resisted on behalf of respondent

but in view of the circumstances stated in the application and during the course of hearing, petition filed under Section 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 titled Amandeep v. Pooja @ Sandhya is ordered to be transferred from the Court of Civil Judge,(Senior Division), Bathinda to judicial Courts at Chandigarh. District Judge, Chandigarh, shall proceed with the petition either in his own Court or may entrust it for trial to some other Court of competent jurisdiction. Court of Civil Judge, Senior Division, Bathinda shall transfer the entire record of the case to the transferee Court, forthwith.

Parties through their respective counsel are directed to appear before learned District Judge, Chandigarh, on 18.03.2015.
