Dr. BHARAT BHUSHAN PARSOON, J.

In this petition, petitioner-wife seeks transfer of petition under Section 13 (1)(i-a) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Chandigarh to Kurukshetra, inter alia, averring that the petitioner is residing at Kurukshetra which is at a distance of about 100 Kms. from Chandigarh and there being no competent male member in her family to accompany her to Kurukshetra on each and every date of hearing, she will have to face great hardship.

It is also urged that the petitioner-wife had also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. against the respondent-husband, at Kurukshetra and vide order dated 6.5.2013, interim maintenance @ Rs.10,000/- was allowed in favour of the petitioner. The revision petition filed by the respondent is stated to be pending at Kurukshetra.

In view of the submissions made by counsel for the parties as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

Sequely, the petition under Section 13(1)(ia) of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Chandigarh is transferred to District Judge,

Kurukshetra who may assign it to the court of competent jurisdiction. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

Disposed of accordingly.
