Dr. Bharat Bhushan Parsoon, J. (Oral):

No appearance for respondent No.1 despite service. Proceeded against ex-parte.

Counsel for the petitioner seeks transfer of the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short the Act) filed by the respondent-husband for dissolution of marriage by decree of divorce from Jalandhar to Mohali.

It is also urged that the petitioner is suffering from chronic disease of fibroids and diabetes and in these circumstances, it will be very painful and tiring for her to take on long travelling, thereby proving these proceedings a mere persecution for her. To substantiate her claim in this regard, the petitioner has appended her medical history on record.

In view of the submissions made by Counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained, the request is allowed.

Sequelly, the petition under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 pending at Jalandhar is transferred to Mohali. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

The petition stands disposed of.
