There was no representation on behalf of the respondent despite due service on the previous date of hearing i.e. 8.12.2014. Today also, no one has put in appearance on his behalf. He is, consequently, proceeded against ex-parte.

2. Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of suit for permanent injunction filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Ludhiana to Malerkotla, District Sangrur as the petitioner is residing with her parents and a minor daughter aged about 4 years at village Abaspura, Tehsil Malerkotla, which is more than 60 Kms. away from Ludhiana.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC against the respondent-husband, which is pending adjudication at Malerkotla.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as

also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the suit for permanent injunction pending before Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana is transferred to District Judge, Sangrur, who may further transfer the same to some other court of competent jurisdiction at Malerkotla. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
