Counsel for the wife, petitioner herein, seeks transfer of petition under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, the Act) filed by the husband, respondent herein, from Ambala to Ferozepur as the petitioner is residing with her parents at Ferozepur which is approximately 250 Kms away from Ambala.

3. It is also urged that the petitioner-wife has also filed a petition under Section 125 Cr.PC at Ferozepur.

4. In view of the submissions made by counsel for the petitioner as also the circumstances explained in the petition, the request is allowed.

5. Sequelly, the petition under Section 9 of the Act pending before Additional District Judge, Ambala is transferred to District Judge, Ferozepur. Both the concerned District Judges to comply.
6. Disposed of accordingly.
